## PAPER SUBMISSION AND PUBLICATION

The proceedings of the previous conferences of the CEE-SET series have been accepted for publication as part of the Springer Lecture Notes in Computer Science (LNCS) series and we will do our best to arrange similar publication this year. Therefore, submitted papers must be written in English and they must be prepared according to Springer's LNCS style (<http://www.springer.com/computer/lncs>). They have to present original research, all submitted papers must be unpublished and not submitted for publication elsewhere. At least one author of each accepted paper must attend the conference to present the paper. Papers should be submitted electronically in PDF format. Final papers shall not contain more than 12 pages in the format specified by Springer. All prospective authors are asked to submit an electronic copy of their manuscript according to the IMPORTANT DATES below through the following web site:

In addition to the potential LNCS publication, authors of selected further papers will be invited to prepare revised and extended versions for publication in special issues of scientific journals including the e Informatica Software Engineering Journal.
