The company/institution acknowledges that with the Legal Entity Membership Fee it contributes to the operation of the Society, among others in the following areas:

- a) organisation costs of new methods, research results, foreign experiences, introductory lectures, meetings, conferences exhibitions organised for the purpose of assisting the experience exchange of companies, institutions;
- b) mission costs of study tours, excursions, missions serving the experience exchange between companies, institutions. A part of the costs is covered by the Society, an other part of the costs is covered by the participants;
- c) offering awards and special prizes for solving different scientific economic and organisation tasks;
- d) supporting the professional and regional groups of the Society;
- e) reproduction costs of work committee publications, "ad hoc" reports and tender results;
- f) remuneration of lecturers holding outstanding lectures, the members of work committees or other activists, who achieve outstanding results in other operation areas of the Society;
- g) other operation costs related to the work of the Society;
- h) sponsoring participation at different events.

John von Neumann Computer Society (NJSZT) provides for its legal entity members the following services:

- 1) in newsletter "Mi Újság" /What is the news?/ of the Society issued monthly – sent regularly in exchange for the legal entity membership fee – the Society informs the legal entity member companies and the individual members about the current events of the profession, about the times and venues of the events;
- 2) upon the request of the company/institution the Society organises lectures, meetings covering the agreed topics for refunding;
- 3) the Society recommends capable experts for carrying out professional tasks;
- 4) encourages and supports the entry of experts working at the legal entity member companies into the Official Register of IT Professionals;
- 5) upon the request of legal entity members it organises exhibitions and products shows, and legal entity member companies/institutions may participate on this type of NJSZT events;
- 6) the Society allows legal entity members to promote their activities at the events of the Society;
- 7) at some of the participation fee events of the Society, the Society offers for one employee of the legal entity member company/institute preferential participation;
- 8) advertisement possibility at discounted price in NJSZT newsletter "Mi Újság";
- 9) legal entity members may use the rooms of the Society events at a discount;
- 10) legal entity members may ask NJSZT to assist in solving other special, professional problems;
- 11) the Society provides societal assistance for the purpose of organising professional, scientific advanced training, and domestic and foreign experience exchange;
- 12) NJSZT represents its legal entity members both in associated organisations and abroad;
- 13) legal entity members may use the submitted works of NJSZT invited tenders;
- 14) the experts of legal entity members enjoy priority when participation in professional foreign tours organised or funded by NJSZT are awarded, in respect of professional information transfer.
- 15) Publication of news in NJSZT newsletter "Mi Újság" about the newly admitted legal entity members (name, address data).
- 16) Brief (about 1/8 page) company introduction in newsletter "Mi Újság" about the newly admitted members.
- 17) One column interview (possibly with photo) in newsletter "Mi Újság".
- 18) Indicating the company under the title of "Our supporters" in the English, Hungarian and German language introductory material of NJSZT, in its publications that are distributed at events and in the framework of other NJSZT actions.
- 19) Post service at preferential rate for the members of the Society using databases requested.
- 20) Link to the homepage of the Society.
- 21) Publication of an interview or company information on the homepage under the title of "Our main supporters".

In addition to the above, legal entity member companies – upon their own initiative – may advertise themselves and their products in all the action that are organised by NJSZT, and they may initiate such actions.

This Agreement enters into force on the day of its signatures. Parties may terminate the Agreement with a 3 months termination period, in writing. We can accept legal entity membership termination letters arriving till the 10th of the given month for given month. In view of inflation and in order to reduce administration, Parties also agree that NJSZT is entitled to invoice an annual 15 per cent membership fee increase without the modification of the present contract.
